



**SATURDAY & SUNDAY, JULY 9 & 10, 2011**

**2011 ON-THE-WAY-TO-PERRY REGIONAL PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP**

**LOCATION:** Blue Grass Sportsmen's League Pistol Range. See enclosed map.  
Jessamine County, KY (near Lexington KY) outside Wilmore KY.

**SPONSORED BY:** BLUEGRASS PISTOL CLUB

**TIME OF FIRING:** Firing will begin at 9:00 a.m. Eastern Time each day.  
If a second relay is required on Saturday, firing will begin at 7:30 a.m.

**First time shooters must arrive sufficiently early for registration (SR-1) and to attend a Safety Briefing 30 minutes prior to the match.**

**PROGRAM:** Saturday: 2700 individual matches.  
Sunday: Team matches, CMP Service Pistol (leg) match and NRA Distinguished Revolver Match.

**MATCH FEES:** "SHOOT THE WORKS" (16 individual matches) for \$50.  
Leg Match \$10 cash.  
Individual matches are \$3 each, plus registration fee of \$9.  
Post entry (late registration) fee of \$10.  
Team matches are \$8 per team per match.  
(Total of \$6 each for four shooters in three matches.)  
Make checks payable to Glen Wood.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to any individual. Teams will consist of four (4) firing members, one alternate, a captain and/or coach, and will represent either a club affiliated with the NRA (Rule 2.11 A or B), a regular service or reserve unit, including the National Guard (Rule 2.13), or a law enforcement agency (Rule 2.14). State Association Teams (Rule 2.12) may enter the team matches (Rule 2.12). The team captain and/or coach may be firing members of the team. Pick up teams are not allowed (Rule 2.10).

The Match Director, Chief Range Officer, Chief Statistical Officer and Official Referee may not compete in any Registered Tournament where they are officiating (Rules 11.1, 11.2 & 11.6).

**NRA NUMBER:** In order to enter scores of competitors in the computer classification system, the competitors who are NRA members must provide their NRA member ID. Non-NRA members who have a classification number must put that number on their entry card.

**RULES:** Current NRA Conventional Pistol Rules and this program will govern.  
The EIC match will comply with CMP Competition rules.  
Minimum of two teams to make a Class.

**SOUVENIR AWARD:** A souvenir award will be issued to each competitor.

**CLASSIFICATION:** The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Individuals who have not been classified will fire in the High Master Class. Rule 19.6 [Assigned Classification] may be used.

# Bluegrass Pistol Club

**CATEGORIES:** There will be only two categories: Civilian & Service. Members of active service, National Guard & reserve, plus law enforcement will comprise the Service category. All others will be considered in the Civilian category.

**CHALLENGES:** A challenge fee of \$2 will be charged for each challenge made. If the challenge is sustained the fee will be returned. Statistical challenges must be made not later than one (1) hour after completion of firing each day. See Rule 16 for correct procedure.

**ENTRIES:** Advance entries are **REQUIRED**. Email your entry intentions to Glen Wood at: [glenewood@hotmail.com](mailto:glenewood@hotmail.com). If you have never competed in a match at BGSL, please mail a completed SR-1 card, accompanied by a check, money order or NRA points, to Glen Wood, 2411 Shun Pike, Nicholasville, KY 40356, (859) 492-4668. **Include your telephone number and email address on your SR-1 card or email.** Circle the number of each match in which you wish to fire. Individual entries will be honored in the order received. Package fee competitors will be given preference. Entries close on Friday, July 8th. Post entries will be accepted until the range is full or until the first relay has completed match 4, providing the late entries will not require a special relay. Range limit is 90 competitors: 2 relays of 45. Prepayment of advance entry fee will be refunded to persons unable to participate.

Team entries close at noon on Saturday, July 9th.

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded. The first 45 competitors to submit entries will be squadded on the 9 a.m. relay. After that relay is filled, competitors will be assigned to the 7:30 relay and will be so notified by telephone. Squadding tickets for individual matches will be issued from the Statistical Office and will be available the day prior to the first firing day. Competitors must call for these tickets as soon as they arrive. NRA membership and classification cards must be exhibited before issue of squadding tickets. Squadding information for team matches will be announced on the range. A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding ticket or who fails to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right to compete in that event.

## **COURSE OF FIRE:**

Firing will begin at 9 a.m. Eastern Time each day.

If a second relay is required on Saturday, firing will begin at 7:30 a.m. and all competitors assigned to that relay will be so notified.

**Twenty-two Caliber, Center Fire and Forty-five Caliber Team Awards – Matches 17, 18 & 19**

Winning Team - Four medals furnished by NRA for each caliber; no cash award.  
 After removal of Winning Team, each Class Winner will be awarded 75% of total entry fees for that class for each caliber. No further awards for overall or aggregate winners.  
 Minimum of two teams to make a Class.



**EIC Service Pistol Individual Match:**

No cash awards. Competitors must furnish their own, proper ammunition. The EIC match will comply with CMP Competition rules.

**NRA Distinguished Revolver Match:**

No cash awards. Competitors must furnish their own, proper ammunition. The NRA Distinguished Revolver Match will comply with NRA Distinguished Revolver Match rules.

**TARGETS:** NRA B-6 (50 yard) and B-8 (25 yard)

**GENERAL:** Complete 900 gun will be fired before changing relays.  
Competitors will score targets as directed by the range officer.  
Use of plug-type scoring gauges restricted to range officials.

**CAMPING:** Competitors who wish to tent or trailer camp may do so at the Range. Make arrangements in advance with Paul DeMichele (859) 230-1112. No charge, but please check in at the gate when you arrive and ask where to locate your rig. Call (859) 230-1112 if you expect to arrive after 9 PM when the gates are locked.

**LUNCH:** The host club will provide Lunch on Saturday only.

**PRACTICE:** The range will be available to competitors for practice on Friday, July 8 from 1 until 6 p.m.

**NOTICE:** Management reserves the right to alter the match schedule in accordance with weather or range conditions.

**MAP:** Accompanying sheet has a map.

**DIRECTIONS TO THE BLUE GRASS SPORTSMEN'S LEAGUE:**

From the North: Follow I-75 south to Exit 115. Turn right onto Newtown Pike towards Lexington. Turn right onto 4 (New Circle Road). Exit onto 68 west (actually south); turn right towards Harrodsburg. Route 29 joins 68 from your left.

**[A]** Stay on 29/68 another half mile. At Marathon station/food store keep straight on 29, this requires turning left off 68 across traffic. Go through Wilmore. Stay on 29. From south edge of Wilmore:

1 mile to broadcast tower (then railroad overpass) 3/4 mile further to Handy's Bend Road (opposite white house)

Road sign is sometimes missing but turn left; stay on Handy's Bend Road for 2 miles to its end at the BGSL. Please obey 25 and 35-mph speed limits. Go through Club gate follow signs to the Range. Please obey 20-mph speed limit.

From the East: Follow I-64 west to I-75 south and exit very quickly at Exit 109. Turn right onto Man-O-War Boulevard. Turn left onto 27 (Nicholasville Road). Turn right onto 29 and, later, left onto 29/68 combined. Then follow directions in **[A]** above.

From the South: Follow I-75 north to Exit 104. Turn left towards Lexington. Turn left onto Man-O-War Boulevard. Turn left onto 27 (Nicholasville Road). Turn right onto 29 and, later, left onto 29/68 combined. Then follow directions in **[A]** above.

From the Southwest: Take the Bluegrass Parkway to its end. Bear right onto 60 (Versailles Road) and at Bluegrass Airport turn right onto Man-O-War Boulevard. Exit onto 68 west (actually south); turn right towards Harrodsburg. Route 29 joins 68 from your left. Then follow directions in **[A]** above.

From the West: Follow I-64 east to Exit 58. Turn right onto 60. Go past Versailles to Lexington on 60 (Versailles Road) and at Bluegrass Airport turn right onto Man-O-War Boulevard. Exit onto 68 west (actually south); turn right towards Harrodsburg. Route 29 joins 68 from your left. Then follow directions in **[A]** above.
